On behalf of the Government of Japan, Mr. Masanori Nakano, Consul-General of Japan in Chennai, signed a Grant Contract with the Organization, for the amount of US Dollar 101,331 on 11th October 2012. Since then, the grant had been utilized for the construction of a multi-purpose resource center which provides vocational training and capacity-building for vulnerable women, youth and agricultural workers. The Organization anticipates that the project will be great empowerment for the marginalized communities in the region.
