The Organization installs medical equipment including Oculus Biom Wide Angle Observation System, Lens Star and Slit Lamp, which allow more complicated and advanced surgical operations. A 37-seater vehicle, also funded by the GGP scheme, is expected to improve the access to eye care by providing transportation for medical teams and patients in remote areas where the lack of public transports has been hindering treatment of curable ailments.
