

Grant Assistance for Grassroots Projects (GGP) in FY 2019 Grant Contract Signing Ceremony

On 11 December 2019, a Grant Contract was signed between Mr. Kojiro Uchiyama, Consul-General of the Consulate-General of Japan in Chennai and Mr. M. Thippeswamy, Chairperson of Rural Development Trust in respect of “the Project for Installation of Medical Equipment for the Hospitals in Anantapur District, Andhra Pradesh” under the scheme of Grant Assistance for Grassroots Projects (GGP) by the Government of Japan at the Consulate-General of Japan in Chennai.

This project will equip three medical institutions Rural Development Trust runs; general hospital, children’s hospital, infectious diseases centre, with medical devices, and be of benefit to more number of the sick and wounded of the underprivileged, including children and women, to receive quality medical care and treatment. Their medical services will help to uplift the lives of the underprivileged in leading a decent life in society.
