About the Film

The story depicts the fears of a modern society; portrays the distress of the family of a juvenile criminal and the conflicts of the Detective ordered to protect them. The 'Funamura' family is the target of mass media attention after their first son commits an act of murder. Detective Katsuura takes the lead role of protecting the bewildered daughter of the family, 'Saori', being



exposed over the internet. In a deadly game of hide and seek, Katsuura and Saori are eventually freed from the malicious attempts of internet addicts. The movie is produced by Usui Hiotsugu and Taneda Yoshihiko of Fuji Television Network, directed by Kimizuka Ryoichi.

(The film shared the best screenplay prize with Welcome to Farewell-Gutmann at the Montreal World Film Festival alongside Grand Prix winner Departures, which went on to win the Oscar. The film also screened at festivals in Newport Beach and Santa Barbara.)
