Qualifications and Conditions	In addition to the Qualifications and Conditions listed in the Guidelines, minimum of 65% marks in 12 th (or 11 th) grade are required. * Preference will be given to candidates with Japanese Language proficiency.
Term of scholarship	A grantee who studies at a preparatory educational institution prior to enrolling in a university: From April 2024 to March 2029 (Including one-year intensive preparatory courses of Japanese language and other subjects, which are necessary to proceed to the university.) A grantee who enrolls directly in a university, without the preparatory intensive courses (direct placement): Four years (or six years for the one majoring in veterinary medicine or in a six-year course in pharmacy). The scholarship period will start from the time of enrolment in the university, which the university designates.
