### Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

- Q. Do I need to submit my Original Transcripts along with the Application?
- A. No you have to submit copies of your transcripts duly attested by your School/University Head or by Gazetted Officer with signature and seal.
- Q. Do I have to submit the Recommendation letter, if so from whom should I get it?
- A. Yes, you have to submit the recommendation letter in the format specified. Recommendation letter should be obtained from either a class teacher or principal of last school attended
- Q. Where should the application and the documents to be sent to the Embassy or Consulate?
- A. If you are applicant from the Southern Region (Tamilnadu, Telangana, Andhra Pradesh, Kerala and Puducherry) you have send your application documents to the Consulate-General of Japan in Chennai. For other regions visit the Embassy of Japan, New Delhi's home page.
- Q. From whom should I get the Health Certificate? Do I have to submit the Lab reports with the Certificate?
- A. The Health Certificate has to be duly certified by a Registered Medical Doctor with his register number, seal and signature. Lab reports are not required to be submitted.
- Q. Do I have to write the Japanese Language Exam compulsory? If I do not write the Japanese Language

#### will it affect my selection process?

Yes, Japanese Language Exam is compulsory. No it will not affect your selection process. But Applicants must be willing to learn Japanese. Applicants must be interested in Japan and be willing to deepen their understanding of Japan before and after arriving in Japan. In addition, in principle, applicants must be willing to carry out their academic studies in Japan in Japanese.

# Q. What is the procedure and formalities that I should follow to send the documents to the Consulate whether it is through post or email?

A. You have to send the documents either by Speed Post or Courier. Email submission will not be accepted.

## Q. If I have to pursue Master's studies, where should I see for the application guideline and whom to contact?

### Q. Where should I come to write the Exam for the MEXT Scholarship?

A. Students who have applied with the Consulate-General of Japan in Chennai have to come to Chennai to write the exam.

### Q. Will the entire expenses borne by the Government of Japan for the MEXT Scholarship?

A. To & From Air Fare, Tution Fees, with a month allowance will be paid by the Government of Japan. Please refer Application Guidelines for further details.

#### Q. When will I get to know whether I have been finally

#### selected for the MEXT Scholarship or not?

- A. The Final Results will be declared in December by MEXT every year, and the selected candidates will be intimated by the Embassy of Japan in New Delhi.
- Q. Whether we can apply for Medicine or Dentistry through MEXT Scholarship?
- A. No Indian students cannot apply for Medicine or Dentistry.
